

# Davenport Green Hall



This stunning venue is set in acres of beautiful Cheshire countryside in the heart of the North West's exclusive Hale, close to Manchester. The Davenport Green Hall offers the perfect backdrop for an event that requires a blend of professionalism and style.

Built in 1617, the estate was owned by Richard Grantham who commanded in the parliamentary arm in the civil war.
