EICC

The EICC is a purpose-built, world class conference venue located in the heart of Edinburgh's financial district. The EICC is an impressive ochre stone, glass and steel, drum-shaped building featuring an exuberant curved entrance. The exterior architecture is striking; however it is the interior has the wow factor for cutting edge design

Unique features:

The 1,600sqm multi-purpose hall boasts a state of the art bespoke moving floor system which can transform depending on purpose: from flat-floored exhibitions, tiered banquets, a ranked auditorium, arena set ups, and extended catering facilities for up to 1,400 people.

It also has four suites which subdivide to 11 fully self-contained meeting areas ideal for breakout sessions or catering.

Transport to the EICC:

Getting to the EICC is easy once you have arrived in Edinburgh.

The Haymarket Train Station is only a 5min walk from the EICC and Waverly Train Station is a 15 minute walk.

If you travelled into Edinburgh by air, it takes 20 minutes to get to the EICC by road from Edinburgh Airport, and there are over 1,000 taxis available in Edinburgh to get you where you need to be.
