The Property

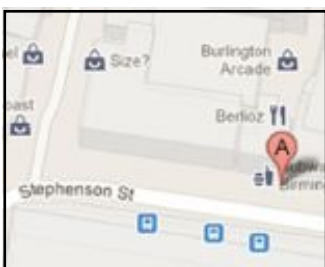
