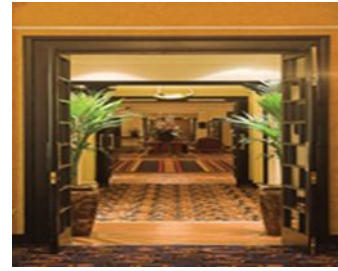

Q Hotel Queens



A stunning 4 star hotel in the heart of Leeds, Q Hotels The Queens has a reputation for being one of the most iconic hotels in the city. Its beautiful white Portland stone façade radiates a powerful presence which continues throughout this striking Art Deco hotel. Recently having undergone a £10.5 million restoration, the hotel has carefully managed to retain a perfect balance of old character and contemporary charm. The Queens hotel first opened in 1863, being one of the many great railway hotels of the time built to cater for increasing numbers of travellers. The hotel was closed in 1935 and re-opened in 1937 and today remains as popular now as it did in the late 19th century.

Location

The Queens Hotel stands proud in the centre of Leeds, adjacent to the train station and just minutes walk from the huge choice of shops, bars and restaurants.

Exclusive QClub with 18 exclusive deluxe bedrooms. Located on the 8th floor, these bedrooms have amazing views of Leeds City.

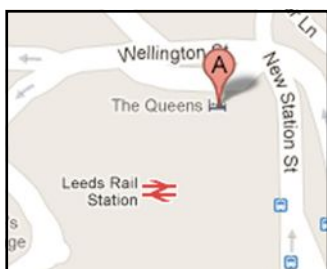
Highly recommended is The Queen's famous Yorkshire afternoon tea which prides itself on local produce.
