- Sienna Spa offers a relaxing retreat away from a busy day, complete with pool, spa treatments and fitness zone

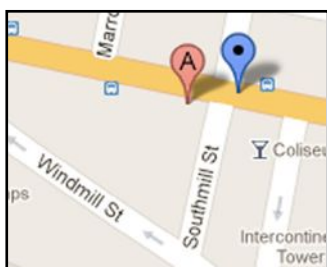
Unique Features
