

## SECC



The Scottish Exhibition Conference Centre is the perfect location for any event. It's superbly situated in Glasgow, Scotland's largest and most stylish city. The Centre provides a wide range of conference and exhibition facilities along with 4 star hotels all under one roof. The 3,000 seat, Clyde Auditorium is not only superbly equipped, purpose-built conference centre, it has become an icon of Glasgow and a symbol of the regeneration of the river Clyde.

### Location

The SECC is located in the heart of Glasgow in Finnieston Quay, close to the Financial Services District, Buchanan Street and Princes Square.

### The Property

- 22,355m<sup>2</sup> of flexible space, in five halls, ranging in size from 775m<sup>2</sup> to 10,065m<sup>2</sup>, all at ground level.
- Retractable partition walls can shape halls to your exact requirements, making them as large or as small as you wish.
- Two purpose built auditoria and an additional 31 meeting rooms, equipped with technical facilities of the highest standard.
- The Clyde Auditorium, referred to locally as 'the Armadillo' offers 3,000 seats over three levels
- Smaller conference rooms such as the Forth and Gala suites which can accommodate a maximum of 140-300 people
- Three hotels
- Dining and drinking options include the Gallery Bistro, Costa Coffee, the Terrace Bar and the Quay West Brasserie
- Medical centre
- Business centre
- Parking for 2,865 vehicles

### The Hotels

For your convenience there are 3 hotels located on site:

- The four star Crowne Plaza has 283 bedrooms and is connected to the SECC by a covered link. There are 8 meeting rooms and can cater for up to 1000 people.
- The four star Mint hotel has 164 bedrooms and 4 meeting rooms for up to 100 guests.
- The Campanile has 106 bedrooms and 5 conference rooms with a capacity of 120 people.

### Transport

Glasgow has a well-developed transport system featuring numerous bus services and an extensive rail network and flight links. Glasgow Prestwick Airport is a 45 minute drive by direct motorway link from the SECC. Glasgow International Airport is a 15 minute drive from the SECC, and provides direct access to and from European cities. The city sits on a nationwide transport system with fast rail and road access to all the UK's principle cities.
